HEP C Screening/Risk Corridor	<p>In spring 2019, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) made major changes regarding hepatitis C virus (HCV) treatment covered by Oregon Health Plan. These changes specifically eliminated prior restrictions to hepatitis C treatment and have made successful treatment more readily accessible to PacificSource members.</p> <p>PacificSource's asks include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow along your own clinic's screening rate and work to develop workflows that would allow you to get all adult patients screened once, especially those who are at higher risk. • Help us to get to goal each year by supporting finding members who are positive and help get them to treatment. • Work through this list and see if there are members who could be considered for treatment if they have not yet been treated. 	
Q1 WHC Quality Pool Distribution Framework	<p>After careful consideration, and multiple discussions with our Board of Directors, a decision was reached to use the same model that the WHC used in Q3 and Q4 of 2020 (details below). We still need to develop a model for future distributions, and both QIM workgroups have created wonderful products to contribute to those conversations.
