Connect Oregon/Unite Us Network Development Update	 Connect Oregon fits into ongoing imitative such as: Oregon InCK grant: 7-year federal grant to improve child health, reduce avoidable inpatient stays and out of home placement, and create sustainable alternative payment models (APMs). OHA and Oregon Pediatric Improvement Partnership (OPIP) manage the grant and your practice may have been hearing about this grant. InCK Model Regions are located in two PacificSource CCO regions: Marion/Polk and Central Oregon Grant will leverage existing HIE and CIE (Community Information Exchange) infrastructure & workflows to allow Core Service Providers (clinical & CBO) to use common tools for existing work and grant-related work.
