There are also ongoing monthly live webinar trainings. All training courses are free. Leslie Marshall asked if Capitol Dental staff could take the training or if it would be considered a conflict of interest. Dustin to take back to get clarification from the state. She also asked about members being contacted through redetermination through text or email. Dustin let her know people can opt into SMS text which is a low number and email is pretty low too because members don't typically fill in that portion of the application so only about 4% of PacificSource membership provide their email. Brett asked how to opt in to SMS text. Dustin was not aware of how sign up but we thought it might be through the ONE system. Kiara asked if the SMS text could be an opt out instead of an opt in. Dustin provided that potential associated costs of text make it so OHA is unable to use that as an option. Leslie M. would like PacificSource to provide their nonresponse list to them to help in the effort to ensure members don't lose coverage. Brett asked if there was a way the provider's office could let members know that cover is ending. There is an option for providers to see that in the system if someone reaches out to schedule an appointment.</p>
